Nationals are a Big Deal!

On November 13, 2010, Tulsa FSC witnessed an event that had not occurred since 1993. A TFSC member competed through the USFS qualified Figure Skating Sectional

Championship to place high enough to advance to the U.S. National Figure Skating Championships in January of 2011. We all congratulate Brittany Schmucker and her partner Adam Munday from the Stars FSC of Dallas. The odds of advancing to that level are extreme. To put it in perspective, think of all the 65,000 members of USFS clubs other than Basic Skills, then reduce that number to those competing in Qualified Competitions for advancement to Nationals. Now we have a very small, select number of survivors and one of them is us. Out of 700 USFS clubs. Tulsa will be competing at Nationals.

The last member to advance was Shannon Bryant in 1993. Several of our members competed at Nationals in earlier years: Will Smith 1970; Dr. Hugh C. Graham and sister Margaret Ann Holt in the 1940's and 1950's; J. Barlow Nelson in the 1950's, Dr. Franklin Nelson in the 1950's ... to name a few. But, one can see by the dates that this is a rather rare occurrence. For a club of less than 200 members in the middle of Oklahoma, it is a Really Big Deal! As you may have deduced, National medalists go to Worlds and to the Olympics.

Another Big Deal of last weekend was the $2^{\rm nd}$ place finish for Garrett and Madison Jensen. They had already

qualified for Junior Nationals, but they showed their competitive edge to the crowd at Sectionals. Congratulations to them. Juvenile and Intermediate skaters go to Junior Na-


> tionals and Novice and up go to Nationals. Each competition is a stretch for competitors from all across the U.S. The Jensens are coached by Kimberly Borgos.

Also a Really Big Deal are the two individual skaters, Josiah Curley and Chandler McGoogan, who qualified for Junior Nationals through the Southwestern Regional Championship in Colorado Springs, CO in October. Chandler earned 2nd place in Intermediate Men's and Josiah skated to 4th place. TFSC has not had an individual skater advance to Junior Nationals since Andrew Charrier in 2002. To have not one, but two, individual skaters representing our club on a national level is a major accomplishment. Curley and McGoogan are coached by Boyko Alexiev.





Big Brothers & Sisters Skate Day



RULES:

- Must be a Tulsa FSC member to perform exhibitions due to the sanction requirements and because it is a club organized event.
- For all of these exhibitions, skaters must be where they are told to be AND ON TIME either inside or outside and they have to have their music. BOK requires the music for Oiler's games exhibitions several days in advance. Oiler's games go on until March so Sooner State Games programs can be put on after Christmas.
- Parents must accompany their skaters to the exhibition. Oiler's usually gives the skater and ONE parent a free ticket to the game that follows the exhibition.
- Skater safety is our primary concern. If the ice is not satisfactory, we will cancel the exhibition and hope to move those skaters to another day.

Please note that every effort will be made to accommodate all requests, in accordance with ensuring that there is a mix of high and low skaters and a variety of skating disciplines. This is a great opportunity to showcase the Club, plus enjoy performing in a unique and festive setting. 
