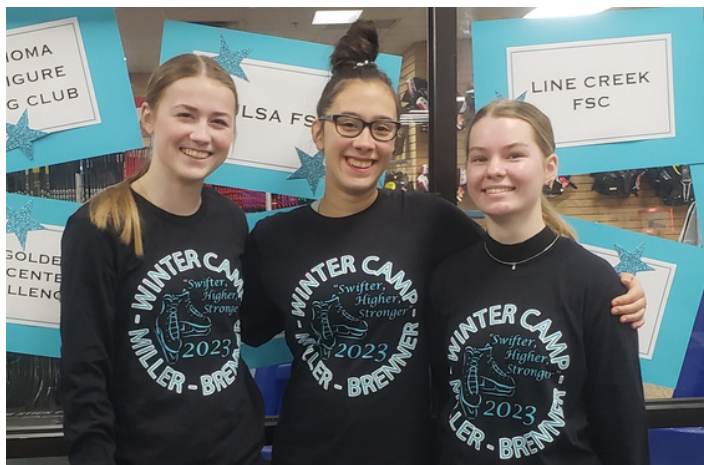
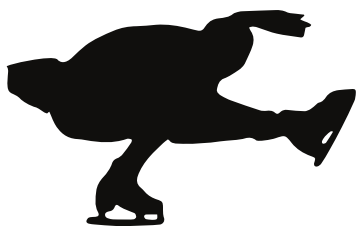

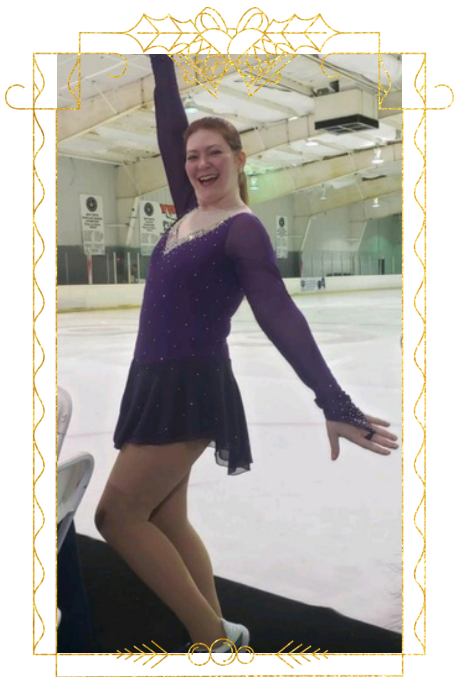

## Newsletter Spotlight! Dr. Hugh Graham

*Dr. Hugh Graham is being recognized by USFS on his 70 years as a judge!* We celebrate with him on this exceptional achievement!! Dr. Hugh Graham's contribution to the TFSC and the figure skating community is to be greatly admired. Growing up here in Tulsa, he skated as a TFSC member and participated with his family in the Tulsa Ice Travaganza. This was an annual ice show put on by the TFSC for the community prior to WWII. He competed as a men's singles skater and as a pairs skater with his sister, Margaret Anne (shown above). He and Margaret Anne were Silver medalist at the U.S. Championships in '53 & '54. They placed 5th at Worlds in Oslo, Norway. Dr. Graham also won Bronze at the 1955 USFS National Championships. (Continued)

He went on to join the Skating Club of Boston and attended Harvard.

Later, he was nominated to serve multiple terms as President of the TFSC and President of the USFS.

As a competitive skater, Dr. Graham knew what he could do to initiate positive change within the structure of U.S. competitions by helping execute standardized skating guidelines. He also served as chair of the competition committee. He was selected as Team Leader for Olympic and International Teams. Dr. Graham judged Worlds, 2 Olympics and major international competitions. He was nominated to the Figure Skating Hall of Fame in 2004. Dr. Graham loves a fast scratch spin and found the double axel and triple loop to be the most challenging of jumps. He admires Red Bainbridge and has fond memories with his life-long skating friend, Frank Nelson.

Dr. Graham's best piece of advice is to use your ice time wisely. Practice.

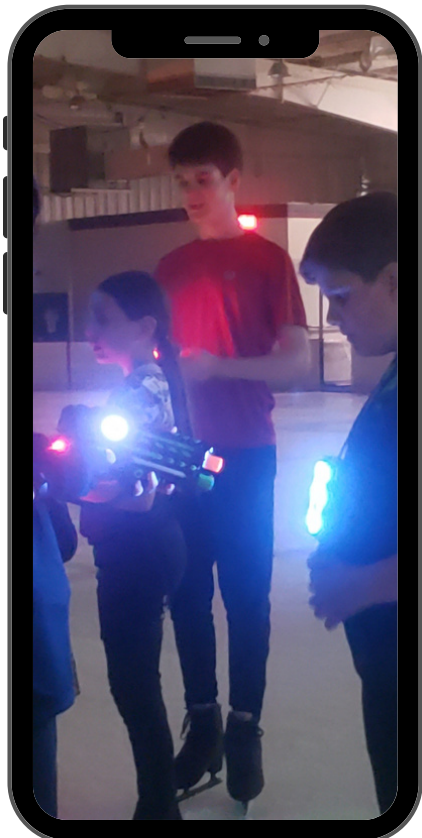
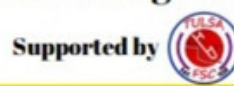
